Rotary Club of Bacchus Marsh – Conditions of Entry – PLEASE READ

Delivery of Paintings.

All Paintings are to be delivered free of charges to the Bacchus Marsh Public Hall, 207 Main Street, Bacchus Marsh on **Sunday - June 6, 2021 between 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM.**

Size of Works.

These size limits will be strictly enforced this year.

There are maximum sizes for exhibits at the show, and works found not to comply with these limits will be excluded from exhibition.

Paintings/photographs must not exceed 1.4 metres in height or width - **Including the Frame.**

Only two paintings/photographs per entrant may exceed 92cm in height or width.

To be considered for Best Small Painting Prize, Small Paintings not to exceed 50cm in height or width, including frame (20cm x 25cm welcome).

Charges, Costs, Prices, and Prizes.

The Rotary Club charges an exhibition fee, which is each Artwork - \$10.00 per Exhibit. PAIRS and TRIPTYCH entries are counted as 2 or 3 entries respectively, but will not be split for individual sale. For this year only, the **5th Entry is free!**

The full fee must accompany the Entry Form. Each artist may enter up to 5 exhibits.

A Sales Commission of 25% will be charged.

All prices will INCLUDE GST, where applicable.

Prize Categories 1 to 9 are NON ACQUISITIVE.

Prize Category 10 is ACQUISITIVE.

The Artist Agrees that:

All entries must remain on display until 3:00 pm Monday, June 14.

All entries are accepted on the condition that they are for sale, not just display or Gallery purposes, at the Art Show.

The Judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Entries must be the original work of the artist, and are to be presented dry and in a 'Ready-to-Hang' condition. Exhibits must not have been shown at any previous Rotary Club of Bacchus Marsh Art Show & Sale.

No refund is available if there is not full compliance with all these Conditions of Entry.

Substitute works will only be considered at the discretion of the Art Show Chairman.

Changes to price or titles can be made on any entry, by application to and acceptance by the Art Show Chairman, and only up to 5pm on Sunday 6th June.

Collection of Unsold Exhibits

All unsold works will be picked up (**NOTE the staggered times for pickup, outlined in the accompanying email/letter**) from the Bacchus Marsh Public Hall, 207 Main Street, Bacchus Marsh on Monday - June 14, 2021 between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM.

STORAGE FACILITIES ARE NOT GENERALLY AVAILABLE BEYOND MONDAY EVENING and so it is essential exhibits are collected on time.

For any works being collected by an agent of the Artist, the agent **must have** a signed authority from the artist.

Items which need your attention.

Best in Show may not be a winner of other sections.

The exhibitor **MUST CHECK** the content of the Confirmation of Exhibits email or letter, and advise any anomalies to the Organisers before 5pm on Sunday 6th June.

It should be noted that artworks will be sold at the prices listed in the Catalogue.

Failure by the exhibitor to notify the Organisers of any required changes by the above appointed time will absolve the Organisers from any Liability, or claim lodged by the exhibitor, or any liability to the exhibitor for any loss.

The Organisers will exercise all reasonable care in handling artworks, but will **not be responsible or accept any liability** for any damage or loss to artworks whilst at the Show.

The exhibitor is responsible for any damage to works whilst they are in transit to and from the Art Show.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the organisers are advised of their correct GST status on the ENTRY FORM and prior to the commencement of the Opening Event.

Please provide an email address and Bank details on the Entry Form.

The Organisers Advise that:

They reserve the right not to award any Prizes, if it is the opinion of the Judge that there is no work of a sufficient standard to meet the requirements of the award category.

They reserve the right to refuse to exhibit any work, for whatever reason.

The Art Show is open to the public over the three days of the long week-end.

Admission charges apply to all people during viewing hours.

For this year only, exhibitors will be given 2 Complimentary Entry Tickets on delivery of Artworks for entry any time during the Art Show. Unsold Artworks may only be collected **from 4pm** Monday, at staggered times.
